2.24- The pendulum

The pendulums can be of different shapes, materials, and weights according to their individual uses and preferences of the dowser. The pendulum can have a very wide repertoire of movements (to the right and to the left) and oscillations (horizontal, vertical, diagonal). It can be used according to a response convention to get yes and no answers. The pendulum is also used to measure the energy of a body or a place. Frequently, the pendulum is used in healing since it detects the bioenergetic fluctuations of the human body. Some applications of the pendulum are the location of objects, minerals, and water. Likewise, you can work on the object of research or on graphs, plans or witnesses faithful to the subject of prospecting. This great flexibility of use makes the pendulum the most used dowsing instrument.
